ABOUT OUR CLASS

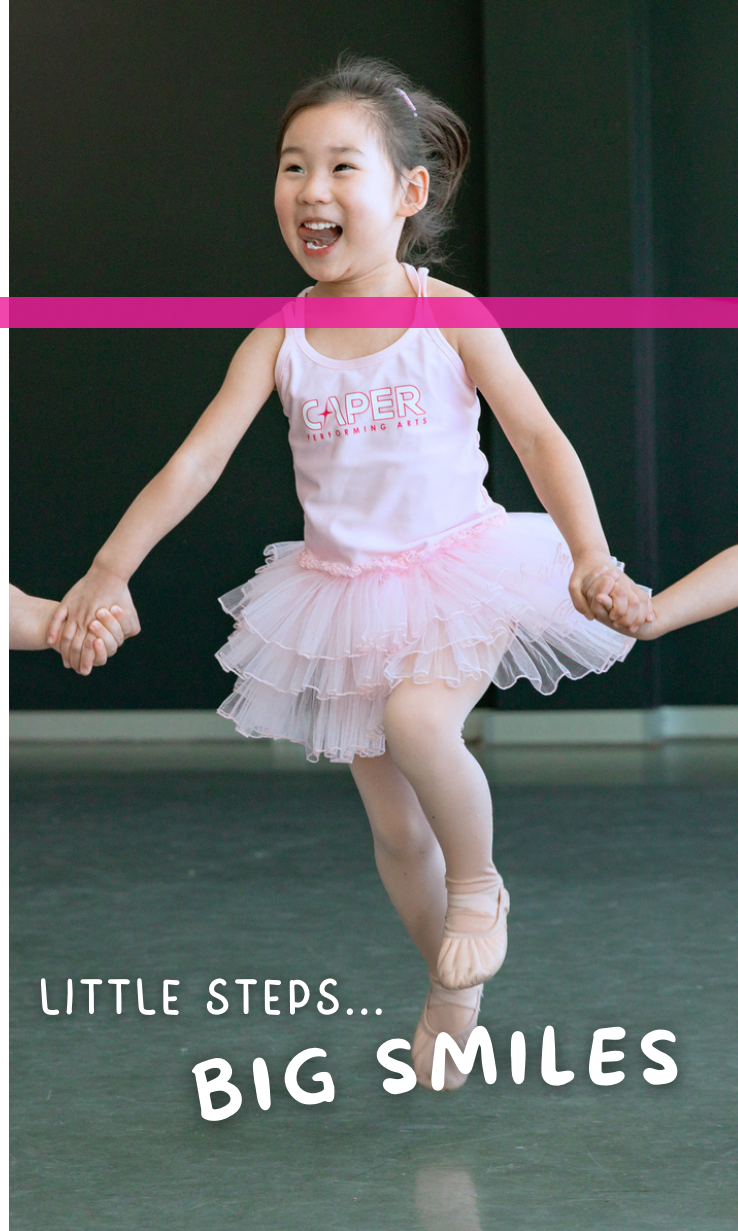
Our classes are a delightful blend of joy and learning. They are designed to nurture your little one's budding creativity and instil a love for dance.

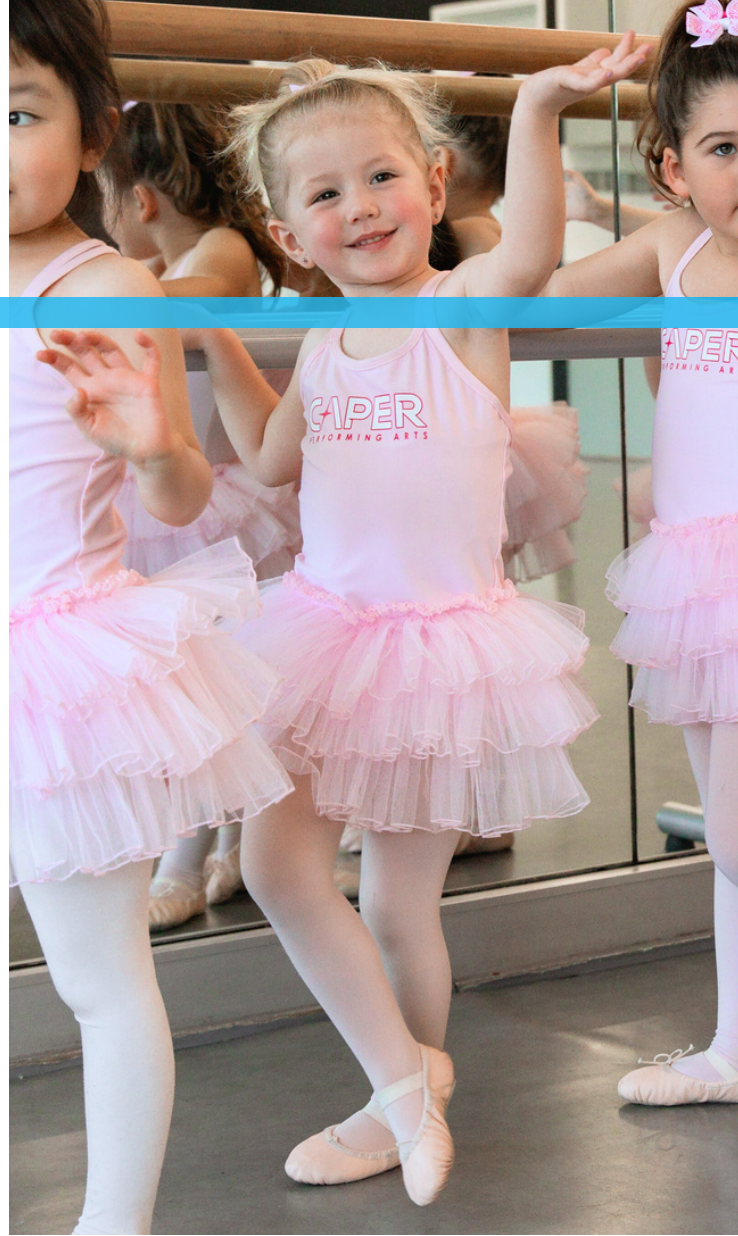

ANY QUESTIONS?

CAN PARENTS WATCH THE CLASS?

We provide an opportunity every lesson for parents to watch from inside the studio, as the last component of the class involves a demonstration by the students. Parents may take photos and be involved in their child's progress and the children love having the chance to perform their skills and receive applause. For the majority of the lesson, parents can watch the class via CCTV on our television screen in the reception area.

DO I NEED TO PURCHASE A UNIFORM?

The uniform can be purchased for \$39.50 (Girls) \$29.95 (Boys).

WHAT SHOES DO I WEAR?

Pink ballet shoes (girls)
Black jazz shoes (boys)
Optional tan tap shoes

The shoes are available from dance wear retailers such as Bloch in Rouse Hill Town Centre and Centre Stage in Seven Hills and Ballet Stuff.

ARE THERE ANY OTHER COSTS?

The only costs required is registration, a uniform and lesson fees. Any other items are optional.

IS THERE A CONCERT?

There is an optional concert in a theatre in Term 4.



WHEN ARE FEES DUE?

Fees are due before the start of the term. If you join mid-way through the term, the fees are calculated pro-rata and are due on your first lesson.

IF I MISS A CLASS DO I HAVE TO PAY?

If you are unable to attend a lesson, you can do a replacement class. Please contact us to arrange this before attending.

WHAT IF MY CHILD WANTS TO STOP?

If after three lessons your child does not want to continue dance classes, we will refund you the remaining weeks in the term.
