

Rep Team provides the opportunity to train at the most advanced level at Caper. It is recommended for students who want to be versatile performers and study many genres of the performing arts. It is also recommended for students who want to complement their training with exams. As the students are working in a team environment, policies and procedures are in the best interest of the team (there may be times where the team's best interest is not the personal preference of the student).

Students are expected to attend each class focused on learning and improving skills. They are required to act respectfully to their teachers, peers and the studio property. It is a privilege to be in Rep Team and there are responsibilities and obligations for accepting the privilege. Your child's enrolment in Rep Team signifies your acceptance of the agreement.

COMMITMENT

- I agree to make Rep Team the priority over other activities.
- I agree to miss no more than one performance (per Rep Team) per calendar year. If due to unavoidable reasons (for example, prolonged injury, extended holiday) please email explaining the situation.
- I agree to attend the annual stage rehearsal.
- I agree to maintain regular attendance to class. I agree to notify Caper via text or email in advance if I am going to be absent from class.
- I will download the Caper App and respond to messages concerning availability within 48 hours. If availability cannot be advised, I will contact Caper to let them know when to expect an answer.
- I will contribute with assistance in transporting props to and from performances
- I agree to lend my child's costume to another student if I am unavailable for a performance.
- I agree to keep fees up to date on a weekly basis
- I understand that if I enrol in more than one Rep Team, that each team requires 100 per cent commitment. *(If enrolling in more than one Rep Team compromises your ability to commit to each one in full, or makes you reluctant to commit fully in terms of costume requirements and attendance, please reconsider your commitment).*

EISTEDDFOD DAY

- I agree to arrive to eisteddfods at the stipulated arrival time, with hair, costume, uniform and make-up ready to go. I will contact Caper if I am running late.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- I agree that speaking negatively about other children enrolled at Caper School of Performing Arts or children from other dance schools at eisteddfods is not in the ethos of the school.
- I agree to bring any concerns directly to Kate and Beth.
- I understand that Caper is unable to offer services to families who engage in aggressive or intimidating behaviour towards its staff.
- Caper is unable to offer services to families who engage in inappropriate communication with current/former Caper staff.
- Caper is unable to provide Rep Team classes to students who attend other dance schools.

COMPULSORY REHEARSALS

- I understand that attendance to all the Rep Team classes the week before a performance is compulsory. I realise that if my child is absent from the compulsory class/es that they may be ineligible to perform in that weekend's performance. I understand that by enrolling in Rep Team that I am agreeing to this rule. If/when it is applied to me I will not be challenging the rule or seeking exceptions.

COMPULSORY CLASSES

A minimum of five classes per week is required to enrol in Rep Team (excluding Year 12 students and Ballet Rep Team). The required classes differ depending on the age group and dance genre. Please refer to the separate list of classes for more detail.
