PRESCHOOL LEVEL

- Preschool tutu (available at Caper Reception)
- Ballet tights or socks
- Ballet shoes (tan tap shoes optional)



JUNIOR LEVEL

- Junior dress (available at Reception)
- Ballet tights or tan matte tights or socks
- Shoes as per shoe guide (corresponds with enrolled dance style/class)



MALE STUDENTS

Male students are to wear the Caper T-shirt (available from reception) with their own plain black shorts or pants.

OPTIONAL ITEMS

Additional items can be ordered at reception such as bags and jackets.



YEAR 2 & UP

Ballet classes:

- Black wide-strap gather front leotard
- Optional sheer black wrap skirt
- Ballet tights
