

2024 Concert Costumes – 10 November – Concert 2

CONCERT DATE 2pm, Sunday 10 November, Riverside Theatre

OTHER ITEMS Students are required to supply their own shoes and stockings. Junior and 6u students wear the same tights for all performances (they do not need separate tights for ballet). It will be stated below if parents need to supply any other costume requirements. All tap and jazz shoes are tan unless otherwise stated. Ballet shoes are pink leather with an elastic strap (including Ballet Rep Team unless it is for pointe shoes). No jewellery is to be worn, this includes earrings, necklaces and watches/activity trackers. Please also remove nail polish.

Students must not go bare foot at Riverside Theatre, this includes contemporary performances.

HAIRSTYLE Monday junior students (Kindergarten and Year 1 at school) are to wear their hair in a high ponytail with curls. All other students (including 6u) are to wear their hair in a low bun with a centre part. Please use lots of hair product and a neutral tone hairnet to keep the bun in place. Boys to have a neat and tidy hair style.

HAIR ACCESSORIES Although many costumes come with a hair accessory provided, it does not necessarily mean that the class will wear the hair accessory on stage. Please read the descriptions to see if your class will be wearing a hair accessory. Due to quick costume changes it will not be possible to securely fasten hair accessories backstage in between items. Any hair accessories (such as bows) are to be positioned on top of the bun/ponytail unless advised otherwise below. Please provide your own bobby pins to ensure the hair accessory does not fall off on stage.

BOYS COSTUMES All male students will be notified individually about their costume requirements. Please email caper@caperonline.com.au if you are unsure.

ARRIVAL TIME Please see the arrival time listed for each class. If you are in more than one class, please arrive at the earliest time stated. Once dropped off at the arrival time, students remain backstage/in dressing rooms until the end of the concert where they are dismissed to parents.

Food/Drinks

Please pack lots of food and drinks for your child. Younger children might also appreciate colouring in books/pencils to occupy themselves during the concert.

Dismissals

The dismissal point will be confirmed after 3 November. It will be either the Stage Door or the Courtyard.

Planning ahead for costume changes

Please check the running order (when it is available on the App) and ensure your child knows the order they are performing their routines (for example, ballet first, then jazz, then tap). The more aware your child is about costume changes the more smoothly our backstage and dressing rooms operate. Make sure you tell them where you have packed everything in their bag, particularly if you are using lots of compartments.

Costume tips

- Put each of your child's costumes into separate plastic zip lock or suit/costume bags. Label the front of each bag with your child's name and all the items inside the bag. For instance, "Jane Smith, pink unitard, blue hat, two spats, two gloves". If your child has multiple costumes, please label each bag in order of performance. Ensure each item inside your labelled bag is also labelled.
- Pre-pin your child's hair accessories. For instance, when packing headbands, place two bobby pins on each side of the headband so your child can slip on the headband and pin it to their head immediately.
- If your concerned about underwear showing underneath your costume, please purchase "dance underwear" from a dancewear retailer. For older students, bras should not be visible.
- Dance shoes can be cleaned with baby wipes and neutral shoe polish.

Make-up

In theatre, make-up is functional and not for aesthetic reasons. Facial features can be washed out under the lights so make-up allows for the performer's expression to be seen clearly. For this reason, we recommend our students applying make-up however it is not compulsory. If applying make-up please use red lipstick, brown eye-shadow, pink blush/bronzer and black mascara/eyeliner. Foundation can also be applied if preferred.
