



2026 EASTER SHOW PERFORMANCE
SHOW TEAM STUDENTS

Updated 24 February 2026

We are very excited about the upcoming Easter Show performance. Below are all the known details however we will update the App if we receive any additional information between now and the performance.

PERFORMANCE DATE

Thursday 9 April 2026 (arrive 11:00am, performance time 12pm **SHARP**)

Confirm your participation by 28 February via the RSVP feature in the App Calendar.

LOCATION & MEETING POINT

Little Big Top Amphitheatre, Sydney Showground, Olympic Park (Sydney Royal Easter Show).

The meeting point will be in the grass area just in front of the amphitheatre (top level). Usually this is nearby the Ferris Wheel and a few food vans.

From the meeting point, the students will be escorted to the backstage dressing room in one group by our teachers. The Easter Show only allows chaperones with prior authorisation in this area so we are grateful for your cooperation in remaining outside of the dressing room and backstage area.

ARRIVAL TIME (11:00am)

Please aim to arrive by **11:00am**. The show is scheduled to start at 12:00pm sharp and will conclude by approximately 12:20pm. We will be unable to delay the performance for late arrivals.

Students should arrive with hair, make-up and all components of the costume ready to go (including shoes). When in public, wearing a jacket or T-shirt over the top of their costume is also encouraged.

The space backstage is limited so bags cannot be brought backstage (unless needed to store medication). This includes food items and water as they are only there a short time.

DISMISSALS

Parents are required to wait until the show concludes to collect their child as we are unable to escort students back and forth to parents whilst the show is still in progress.

Students will be dismissed one class at a time (youngest class to oldest class) from the backstage entrance. Caper staff will be trying their best to dismiss students safely and orderly and we thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation.

COSTUME CHANGES

The Royal Agricultural Society do not allow children and teenagers to change in/out of their costumes in public. If you need to change out of your costume after the performance, the best place is in the dressing room provided backstage or in a toilet cubicle with the door closed. If you are changing in a toilet block, please ensure it is actually inside the cubicle with the door closed (as opposed to changing outside the cubicle near the sinks where one can be viewed by members of the public). We have been advised that children/teenagers found to be changing their clothes in public will have their studio prevented from performing at the Easter Show in the future.

WET WEATHER

If the performance is cancelled due to wet weather, the App will be updated (we will not contact you individually). Please note that cancellation is at the discretion of the Easter Show. This means that if it is raining and there has not been an App update, it will be because we have not yet been informed by the Easter Show.

The decision to cancel could occur at any time as it is a reaction to the current weather conditions. Therefore, there is the possibility that all the students could already be at the venue when the decision is made to cancel. Whilst we hope that this will not happen, we wanted to forewarn families to be prepared for this possibility. If a show is ever cancelled it is for the safety of performers and it will not be rescheduled.

COSTUME & HAIR

The costume requirements are below. Please refer to the following YouTube link for instructions on doing a bun: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Q3dPpY9Qknc>

Pre-Intermediate "I wanna dance with somebody"

"Material Girl" costume (blue dress and lace mitts/gloves). Provide own tan matte tights and tan jazz shoes. Hair in a low bun with centre part and blue scrunchie pinned around the bun.



Int Show Team "AM to PM"

"Glittering" costume (sequin leotard and white pants). Provide own tan jazz shoes with no socks (tan matte tights can be worn if preferred). Hair in a low bun with centre part and bow pinned on top.



Pre-Snr Show Team "Clap Snap"

"Lucky Star" costume (pink dress). Provide own tan matte tights and tan jazz shoes. Hair in a low bun with a centre part. Purchase \$5.00 rhinestone hair accessory from reception to pin around the bun.



Snr Show Team "Vogue"

"Bad" costume (black/silver shortard with attached peplum). Provide own tan matte tights and tan jazz shoes. Hair in a low bun with a centre part. Purchase \$5.00 rhinestone hair accessory from reception to pin around the bun.



MAKE-UP

We are not very strict on make-up application and it is not compulsory. The following is a general guide:

Base: A cream powder or foundation acts as a good base with bronzer or blush along the cheekbone.

Eye Shadow: Use only tones of brown to highlight the eyes.

Eyeliner: Black eyeliner for above and/or below the eyes.

Eyelashes: Use black mascara for the eyes. False eyelashes are permitted but not compulsory.

Lips: Bright red, long lasting lipstick.

TICKETS

Performers Tickets

We will be given a limited number of complimentary tickets for performers. The App will be updated when they arrive and will need to be collected from reception.

If we are not provided with enough tickets for every Caper student, we will then purchase the shortfall (for example we might be 15x tickets short). We will then split the cost of the additional tickets across all four Show Team classes. Most year's we do not need to do this but when we have had to do it, it was no more than \$7 per student. We will not know if we have enough tickets until we receive everyone's RSVP via the App so we appreciate your prompt attention to submitting your RSVP.
