



# 2024 APPLICATION

Caper is an affiliate member of DanceSTEP with the aim to deliver leadership training to our students. DanceSTEP, an annual module Student Teacher Education Program, provides a progressive and formalised process including both practical and theoretical components. Participants complete one module per year.

DanceSTEP empowers students to take care of others and guides them to be leaders and role models. The program covers assistant teaching skills such as class management, different learning needs and styles, safe dance principles and anatomy. These concepts are taught in a sequential and age appropriate way. Whether students are considering a career in dance teaching or otherwise, the DanceSTEP program is a great preparation for many aspects of life.

## COMMITMENT

DanceSTEP participants receive practical teacher training at one Caper dance class per week. The practical training commences Week 4 of Term 1.

## TRAINING DATES

DanceSTEP participants are required to attend the mentoring sessions to help them with the theoretical components of the course. The dates are below:

## ELIGIBILITY

- Participants must be enrolled in jazz, tap and ballet classes whilst undertaking DanceStep and undertake exams in either tap or ballet.
- There is a fee of \$185 for Level 1 (includes a T-shirt) and \$165 for Levels 2, 3, 4 and 5.
- The fee is non refundable and is due by Tuesday 23 January.
