PERFORMANCE DATE

Monday 13 April 2026 (arrive 10:15am, performance time 11am **SHARP**)

Confirm your participation via the RSVP feature in the App Calendar.

Venue: The Sydney Family Show
The Entertainment Quarter, Moore Park

Students should arrive with hair, make-up and all components of the costume ready to go (including shoes). When in public, wearing a jacket or t-shirt over the top of their costume is also encouraged.

The space backstage is limited so bags cannot be brought backstage (unless needed to store medication). This includes food items and water as they are only there a short time.

LOCATION & MEETING POINT

Follow the red dotted line below from the carpark to the performer's entry which is very close to the stage. Allow time to park and walk to this location. There are other entry gates to this event but this is the only gate to access free entry. When you arrive, you will need to give your child's name at this gate to have their name marked off.

Pre-purchased ticket holders (who do not qualify for free entry) can also enter through the Performer's Gate. Anyone purchasing tickets on the day will have to enter through the main entry where there is a ticket booth.



COSTUME & HAIR

6u Rep Team "Rescue Me"

Red/yellow lifesaver costume. Provide own tan matte tights and tan jazz shoes. Hair in a low bun with centre part with visor/headband pinned to the head.



Pre-Intermediate "I Wanna Dance with Somebody"

"Material Girl" costume (blue dress and lace mitts/gloves). Provide own tan matte tights and tan jazz shoes. Hair in a low bun with centre part and blue scrunchie pinned around the bun.



Int Show Team "AM to PM"

"Glittering" costume (sequin leotard and white pants). Provide own tan jazz shoes with no socks (tan matte tights can be worn if preferred). Hair in a low bun with centre part and bow pinned on top.



Pre-Snr Show Team "Clap Snap"

"Lucky Star" costume (pink dress). Provide own tan matte tights and tan jazz shoes. Hair in a low bun with a centre part. Purchase \$5.00 rhinestone hair accessory from reception to pin around the bun.



Snr Show Team "Vogue"

"Bad" costume (black/silver shortard with attached peplum). Provide own tan matte tights and tan jazz shoes. Hair in a low bun with a centre part. Purchase \$5.00 rhinestone hair accessory from reception to pin around the bun.



MAKE-UP

We are not very strict on make-up application and it is not compulsory. The following is a general guide:

- Base: A cream powder or foundation acts as a good base with bronzer or blush along the cheekbone.
- Eye Shadow: Use only tones of brown to highlight the eyes.
- Eyeliner: Black eyeliner for above and/or below the eyes.
- Eyelashes: Use black mascara for the eyes. False eyelashes are permitted but not compulsory.
- Lips: Bright red, long lasting lipstick.

DISMISSALS

Parents are asked to wait until the show concludes to collect their child as we are unable to escort students back and forth to parents whilst the show is still in progress.

Students will be dismissed one class at a time (youngest class to oldest class) from the backstage entrance. Caper staff will be trying their best to dismiss students safely and orderly and we thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation.

TICKETS

Performers and 1x Parent – Free Entry

Every performer (i.e. Caper student) and one parent will receive free entry on the day. All other spectators will need to purchase a ticket. As previously stated, to gain free entry, Caper students need to enter via the "Performer's Gate" along with one parent who is also provided free entry.

If you opt to pre-purchase tickets, additional ticket holders can enter through the Performer's Gate (present QR code for entry). If you are purchasing any tickets on the day, these ticket holders must enter through the main entry as the Performer's gate does not sell general entry tickets.

Additional Tickets

If families would like to purchase additional tickets, we have been told that a discounted code will be provided. We have followed this up a few times and have not received the details yet. As soon as the details are received, we will pass this on to parents via the App.

WET WEATHER

If the performance is cancelled due to wet weather, the App will be updated (we will not contact you individually). Please note that if the performance is cancelled due to safety concerns, any tickets purchased will not be refunded as the event may still continue (just the performance might be cancelled).

The decision to cancel could occur at any time as it is a reaction to the current weather conditions. If a show is ever cancelled it is for the safety of performers and it will not be rescheduled.
